





## Commonwealth Shared Scholarships

(for pursuing Master's in United Kingdom)

For candidates from low and middle income Commonwealth countries

Commonwealth Shared Scholarships are for candidates from least developed and lower middle income Commonwealth countries, for full-time Master's study on selected courses, jointly supported by UK universities.

Funded by the Foreign, Commonwealth & Development Office (FCDO), Commonwealth Shared Scholarships enable talented and motivated individuals to gain the knowledge and skills required for sustainable development and are aimed at those who could not otherwise afford to study in the UK.

Few examples of relevant courses are: MSc Wild Animal Health / Wild Animal Biology, MSc Veterinary Epidemiology, MSc One Health (Royal Veterinary College), MSc Livestock Science, MSc Animal Science (Aberystwyth University) besides a range of other selected courses (including Public Health).

N.B.: The courses are suitable to students with more than GPA 7.5 or Top 10 % of the B.V.Sc &A.H. class. Most of the UK universities require suitable IELTS academic exam score for showing English proficiency.
